



All measurements are in centimetres (cm). For approximate inch sizes simply multiply by 0.4 (or divide by 2.54).

**Materials:**

yarn **Schachenmayr**, quality **Micro Fino**,

**Flower A:** oddments in #22 sun, #24 papaya, #36 pink, and #30 cherry.

**Flower B:** oddments in #01 white and #99 black.

**Butterflies:** oddments in #70 grass, #52 jeans, and #01 white.

One 2-3 mm [size B/1-D/3] crochet hook, and for the small butterflies additionally two 2.75-3.75 mm [size 1-4 ] doublepointed needles, or size to obtain gauge.

**Accessories:** glue gun, and buttons to suit: for flower A 2 each yellow and pink, and 4 red buttons each 1 cm across; flower B 6 black buttons about 0.5 cm across.

**Small flower:** about 3 cm across. Crochet 5 ch and join to a ring with 1 sl-st. Then work 1 round as foll: \* 3 ch, 2 dc into ring, 3 ch, 1 sc into ring, rep 4 times from \* = 5 petals.

**Large flower:** about 4 cm across.

Crochet 7 ch and join to a ring with 1 sl-st. Then work 1 round as foll: \* 4 ch, 2 tr into ring, 4 ch, 1 sc into ring, rep 4 times from \* = 5 petals.

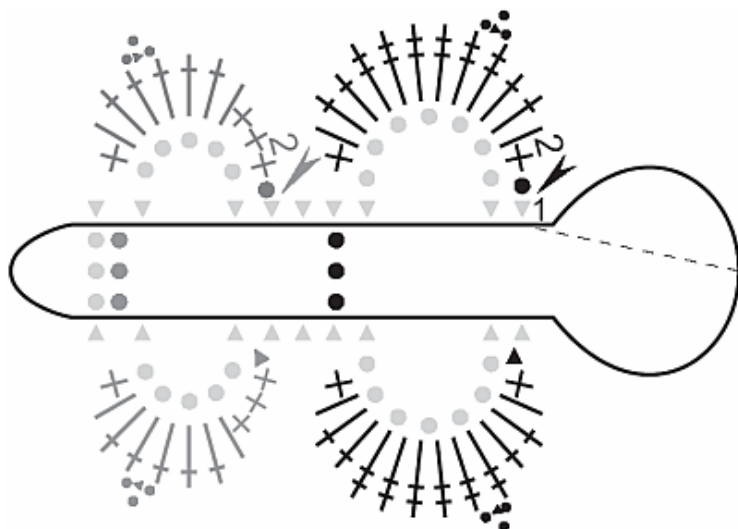
**Flower A:** crochet 2 large flowers pink with 1 small flower each in sun and cherry, 2 large flowers pink with 1 small flower each in papaya, 2 large flowers in sun with 1 small flower each in pink and cherry, 1 large flower cherry with 1 small flower papaya and 1 large flower papaya with 1 small flower pink, and sew tog with the buttons = 8 flowers altog. Using glue gun attach to each strap of the flip-flops.

**Flower B:** crochet 4 large white, 2 large black, 4 small black and 2 small white flowers. Sew 1 each black and white flower tog with the button. Then attach 3 flowers each to the outer straps of flipflops with the glue gun.

**Butterflies:**

First work a cord for the body using 2 of the double-pointed needles as foll: cast on 4 sts. white. \* Do not turn, but slide sts. back to the other end of the needle carrying yarn at back of work, then K4, rep from \* throughout. Pull the cord in length from time to time to distribute the stitches more evenly. On 4th row inc 1 (= make 1 knitwise tbl) = 5 sts. On 16th round inc 1 st. after every st. for head = 10 sts. After 19 rows altog, cut thread about 50 cm long and use to pull sts. of last row up. Then bring yarn into inner body (see broken line) and bring back out below head on outside. With this thread, 1st row pale gray is given, crochet wings, missing about 1 cm of trunk at front of wings with a ch loop, and about 0.5 cm at back of wings. After last sl-st of rear wing go across to other side of the body with 3 ch, and cont 1st row as given. Attach yarn to front pair of wings (marked in black), then crochet around first ch loop, go across to the other side with 3 ch, then crochet around last loop. Finally re-attach yarn as given in pale gray for back pair of wings, and crochet as given.

With glue gun attach butterflies to flipflops.
