

Teddy, about 30 cm tall



All measurements are in centimeters (cm). For approximate inch sizes simply multiply by 0.4 (or divide by 2.54) or see schedule below.

Materials: yarn Schachenmayr, quality Hip Hop 75 g #87 aqua color
quality Jazz
oddments (about 20 g) #75 linden.
For the embroidery an oddment in dark blue.
6-7 mm [size 10-10½] double-pointed needles and 3-4 mm [size 3-5] needles, or size to obtain gauge, plus one blunt embroidery needle.

Accessoires: safety wadding.

Garner stitch: K all rows; in rounds alt K 1 round, P 1 round.

Stockinet stitch (st-st): K RS rows; P WS rows; in rounds K all sts.

Gauge: 9 sts. and 16 rows/rounds each to 10 cm [4"], on 6-7 mm needles.

METHOD

Work legs, trunk and head in one piece in rounds.

Legs: for one leg cast on 3 sts. each on needles 1 and 4, and 4 sts. each on needles 2 and 3 = 14 sts. and work in garter stitch. After 14 rounds = 8.5 cm, slip sts. of needles 1 and 2 onto one needle, and sts. on needles 3 and 4 onto a holder.

Work 2nd leg alike.

In rounds work for trunk over the 28 sts. of legs. Start of round is at center back. After 16 rounds = 10 cm, set a marker for neck.

Cont for head.

3 rounds from marker, cont face as foll: over the last 2 sts. on needle 2 and the first 2 sts. on needle 3 K 2 rounds, then K 2 rounds over the last 3 sts. on needle 2 and the first 3 sts. on needle 3, K 2 more rounds over the last 2 sts. on needle 2 and the first 2 sts. on needle 3; work all rem sts. in garter stitch as before. Then cont over all sts. in garter stitch.

After 12 rounds = head measures 7.5 cm, bind off all sts.

Arms (make 2 alike): cast on 12 sts. and work 10 rounds = 6 cm garter stitch, then bind off all sts.

Finishing: embroider the eyes and nose with satin stitch, the mouth with stem stitch in black onto face, see photo.

Stuff head, trunk and legs, adding extra wadding to face to give it more shape. Close upper head seam, sewing diagonally across ears on either side, see photo. Sew foundation edges of legs tog. Sew small running sts. around neck, then pull neck tog slightly. Sew bound-off edges of arms tog and sew to trunk, then stuff arms. Sew foundation edges tog.

Scarf: about 4 cm wide.

METHOD: cast on 14 sts. Jazz with 3.75-4.5 mm needles and work alt K1, P1.

When work measures 45 cm bind off all sts. Knot tassels into ends of scarf. For each tassel cut 2 threads each about 15 cm long, fold in half, bring loop through scarf with the crochet hook, then the loose ends through the loop. Pull up firmly and trim tassels evenly.

Conversation table from centimeters (cm) to inches: 10 cm = 4" (2.54 cm = 1").
